

8 DAYS CRUISE FOR 8 PEOPLE IN THE NORTH COAST OF JAMAICA

Day 1:

- Arrival to Kingston (Jamaica) and transfer to Port Antonio to check in at the catamaran ZION (Lagoon 52, 2015). Please visit: (1)
- Dinner at any of the restaurants in town.
- Sleep onboard at the pier of the Errol Flynn Marina. Please visit: (2)

Day 2:

- Breakfast onboard.
- Departure for sailing to The Blue Lagoon visiting the surrounding areas. Please visit: (3)
- Picnic lunch on the beach.
- Departure by road to visit and swim to the Summerset Falls. Please visit: (4)
- Returning to the Marina and dinner in town.
- Sleep onboard.

Day 3:

- Breakfast onboard.
- Departing for sailing to Chrystal Beach to do snorkel, kayaking/paddleboard.
- Lunch onboard.
- In the afternoon, return to the Marina and dinner in town.
- At night, departure to Ocho Rios. Sailing at night arriving to Ocho Rios for sunrise.

Day 4:

- Breakfast onboard.
- Departure by road to climb the Dunn's River Falls, visit to the city, shopping at the craft market and lunch at any of the restaurants in town. During this time, the catamaran will be sailed to Discovery Bay. Please visit: (5)
- Transfer to Discovery Bay where we will enjoy the beach during the afternoon. Please visit: (6)
- Dinner onboard.
- Sleep at the anchor on the bay.

Day 5:

- Breakfast onboard.
- Departure to Falmouth to enjoy the different attractions (adventure tours, rafting in a bamboo raft in the Martha Brae River, etc..) and to visit the city. During this time the catamaran will be sailing to Montego Bay. Please visit: (7) and (8)
- Lunch in a typical jerk place to enjoy the Jamaican specialties (pork, chicken or fish). Please visit: (9)
- Transfer to the Montego Bay Yacht Club by road. Please visit: (10)
- Dinner in the same Club.
- Sleep onboard at the pier.

Day 6:

- Breakfast onboard.
- Day to enjoy different activities in Montego Bay including golf (please visit 11), a Day Spa or an excursion (please visit 12).
- Lunch in any restaurants in town.
- Departing Montego Bay and stopping for dinner at the “The House Boat”. Please visit (13).
- After dinner, sailing during the night to Negril arriving for sunrise.

Day 7:

- Breakfast onboard at the anchor in Bloody Bay. Please visit (14).
- Perfect day to enjoy the beach practicing watersports.
- Lunch in any restaurant on the beach.
- Sailing to the reefs to see the Sunset in Rick’s Café. Please visit (15).
- Dinner onboard.
- Sleep at the anchor in Bloody Bay.

Day 8:

- Breakfast onboard.
- Transfer to the Sangster International Airport in Montego Bay.
- End of our services.

What is Included:

- 8 days cruise program with Captain and crew, with all fuel and docking charges.
